Before signing, feel free to ask as many questions as you would like. These policies are in compliance with the Math Department Examination Policy.

- No student is permitted to have any <u>electronic device</u> on his/her person during testing (except for calculators permitted by the syllabus). Any student caught with a device (cell phone, smart watch, iPad, etc.) will receive up to an <u>Unforgiveable F</u> in the course.
- During the test, backpacks, purses, or anything that carries other items will need to be closed and remain in the designated location. <u>Accessing items</u> during the test without permission will result in a <u>zero (0) on the exam</u>.
- Any student arriving <u>late cannot take the exam</u>. You must take the exam with your own lab section.
- Students <u>may not leave and return during the exam</u> for any reason. If you leave the room, then your test must be handed in and you will not be able to come back and complete it. If you have any condition that makes it impossible for you to sit during an entire testing time, then you will need to go to accessibility service and request accommodations for this condition.

- <u>No communication of any kind</u> is permitted between students or with an outside party during any exams. If a student is caught communicating in any way, then they will be given a <u>zero (0) on the exam</u>. If you need to ask something, then raise your hand and ask the instructor. No warnings about this will be given.
- Any student caught <u>misrepresenting his/her identity</u> or taking a test for another student will be recommended for academic probation or dismissal. The person enrolled in the class will receive up to an <u>Unforgiveable F</u> in the course.
- <u>Accessing outside materials</u> during the test will result in a <u>zero (0) on the exam</u>.
- Any repeat offense will earn an F or an Unforgivable F in the course.
